How to: Hang a picture frame wall

Redesigning, renovating or simply updating, a frame wall is an easy and modern way to refresh your space. Here are some tips on how to style your frames to create a unique focal point in your home.

What you need

Spirit level

Tape measure

Hooks and nails or 3M
velcro tabs

Selection of prints,
photographs, drawings

Selection of frames

Masking tape

Hammer

Scissors

Roll of paper

Pencil

How to

1. Trace outlines of the frames onto paper and cut out each shape.
2. Measure the distance between the hook and top of the frame, marking the measurements on your cut out paper.
3. Tape the cut out paper shapes onto your wall with masking tape.
4. Hammer the picture hook or nail so it sits on the mark on your paper, then pull away the paper.
5. Hang your frames using the spirit level to ensure frames are straight and parallel.

Extra tips

- Frames can be installed with 3M velcro tabs but we do recommend nails or screws for extra support for larger frames.
- We recommend the spacing between each frame to be 30mm – 50mm apart.
- A spirit level will ensure all frames are straight and parallel to each other.
- Frame feature walls can be made up of different frame types, finishes and sizes. Do not be afraid to mix Country Road frames with your existing collection.
- You can determine your composition on the floor first so that you have a clear idea of the layout you wish to achieve.
- Make it as personal and fun as you like – mix family heirloom photographs with holiday snaps, prints and kids drawings.
- Be creative, the options are endless.
